

## ADA Insurance Codes for LOCATOR® Root Attachment

For patients who have financial limitations or are unwilling to move forward with traditional implant treatment for other reasons, LOCATOR Root can provide the emotional and health benefits of retention, esthetics and stability vs. traditional dentures or partial dentures with clasps.

Retaining natural tooth roots can also assist with the transition towards dental implants as some patients have limited insurance coverage. Financial considerations of LOCATOR Root can often be very affordable compared to going directly to dental implants as endodontic procedures are readily covered by many dental insurance plans. Preserving the tooth roots helps maintain facial structure and deters future bone loss, leading to predictable outcomes and keeping treatment affordable for patients.



Using the natural tooth root for retention gives the patient time to prepare for the cost and procedure of dental implants in the future.

D5862	Precision attachment by report. Each set of male and female components should be reported as one precision attachment.	\$300-500
D3310	Endodontic therapy, anterior tooth	\$785
D3320	Endodontic therapy, premolar tooth	\$910
D3330	Endodontic therapy, molar tooth	\$1,092
